Small Group Questions

1. What acts of kindness have you recently experienced and how did they make you feel?
2. How might have the expectations of Mary and Judas influenced their choices during this evening? How do our expectations and hopes of God influence our spiritual choices?
3. Read I Peter 4:10-11 - How do these verses help us understand what it means to offer ourselves, our souls and bodies to the service of God?
4. Why are we so easily tempted to live in ways that bring glory to ourselves and ignore the will of God?
5. Read James 4:7 and discuss together the means in which we can overcome temptation.

Map M WEDNESDAY Jesus' Last Week

Mt.26:1-16; Mk.14:1-11; Lk.22:1-6

1. Jesus probably spends the day in Bethany and does not go into Jerusalem. Jesus tells his disciples that the Passover is two days away and the Son of Man will be crucified. (Mt.26:1)

2. The chief priest and the elders are looking for a way to kill Jesus. (Mt.26:2-5; Mk.14:1-2)

3. At an evening meal at the house of Simon the Leper, Jesus is anointed a second time while in Bethany. This time all the disciples object to the waste of valuable oil. (Mt.26:6-13; Mk.14:3-9)

4. Judas goes to the chief priests to discuss a way to betray Jesus. (Mt.26:14-16; Mk.14:10-11; Lk.22:3-6)
